MWF EDUCATION

Minhaj Welfare Foundation has in excess of 150,000 students studying under the branch of Minhaj Education Society (MES)

AGHOSH

An innovative scheme which will house orphans who are under the age of 10, and educate them up to University level and beyond. All aspects of their lives will be taken care of.



MEDICAL CAMPS

Minhaj Medical Camps has treated over 70,000 people with eye ailments. 6,200 of these have been operated on. All treatments have been free.

COLLECTIVE MARRIAGES

MWF was the first charity in the history of Pakistan to pilot this scheme. Since 2005 over 600 couples have been married. MWF provides a full ceremony carefully planned to include all the ingredients of a joyous occasion for those who simply cannot afford it.



A WIDER LOOK AT OUR WORK

Minhaj Welfare Foundation wants to empower everyone that they are all part of a wider system. It means understanding that if we're going to help the world's poor break free from poverty, we must first empower their family & friends, improve their schools, outfit their health clinics and build their water facilities. It means making change sustainable so that they can realise their rights, get their education and live to their full potential.

That's what End the Cycle of Poverty is.

Minhaj Welfare Foundation implements the program in rural and marginalized areas in Pakistan, Nigeria, Kenya, Somalia, Bangladesh and other underdeveloped countries. Designed to meet the basic needs of developing communities and eliminate the obstacles preventing children from accessing education. End the Cycle is made up of four pillars crucial to lifting society from poverty: education, sustainable living, health care, and water & sanitation.



OUR AIMS

To eradicate poverty in the third world and to ensure a sustainable future is provided for the deprived and needy. The work of Minhaj Welfare Foundation focuses on people's basic needs.

EMERGENCY RELIEF AID CHARITABLE EXPENDITURE

More than 20 million people were affected and over 800,000 homes destroyed by floods and landslides brought on by the monsoon rain in Pakistan 2010. The disaster was greater than Tsunami and Haiti combined. We were among the first on the ground providing basic emergency relief.



BETTER EDUCATION CHARITABLE EXPENDITURE

More than 120 million children do not have access to primary education. MWF has more than 630 educational institutes, with more than 150,000 students. We are now developing more than 60 education primary and secondary schools.



BETTER HEALTH CARE CHARITABLE EXPENDITURE

Millions of people die due to inadequate Health Care; MWF has provided accessible Health Care in marginalised areas. It is currently providing hospitals, medical dispensaries, free eye camps and ambulance services.



GENERAL WELFARE CHARITABLE EXPENDITURE

MWF has initiated various programs which provides basic needs for all. It has established more than 750 water pumps, provided bridal gifts for more than 600 couples.





TIPS ON HOW TO FUNDRAISE

NGO = Non Governmental Organisation

EVERY HUMAN BEING IS UNIQUE, unique like their fingerprint. Over time you'll develop your own style of communicating with people. Here is just one example of how you can introduce yourself.

“Hi. I'm from the Minhaj Welfare Foundation. An international charity which operates in over 100 countries.

We're are recognised by the United Nations as the largest NGO for education in Pakistan. We established 630 schools in 12 years. At the moment we're raising funds for some amazing projects....”

Take it from there...

If it is someone who isn't Muslim, adjust your communication so they can understand you.

KEY TIPS

Relay the message to potential donors that –
**Donate whatever you can, – small or large
– every penny makes a difference.**

- Carry your sponsorship form everywhere – you never know when an opportunity may arise. By speaking to people in person about your fundraising efforts they will often want to donate on the spot.
- Rope in some help with the help of your family and friends, and they will be able to reach a wider network of people.
- Make up the first amount on your form – for example £20, as normally people will follow suit.

Have good knowledge of the charity itself. Being a fundraiser the information provided in this booklet is imperative. Remember your donor is giving their **OWN** money away and have the right to ask questions where it will be spent. Therefore make sure you are well equipped with the knowledge of the charity and its aims and objectives.

Most charities will recommend that you do **NOT** raise money for your event by collecting on the street. Please do not do anything unsafe or illegal – everything you do will reflect on the charity and our reputation is very important to us. If in doubt ask our permission first. When holding events in public areas please make sure you are covered by the local authority public liability insurance and that you have the appropriate licences.

WOULD YOU SPONSOR AN ORPHAN?

'AGHOSH' orphan care home

The harsh reality of the world that we live in are as such that children are:

left displaced from the disasters of civil war and natural disasters

working at the age of 5 or 6 years earning less than 2 dollars a month looking towards a better future. Aghosh is one of the most prominent and sustainable programs of Minhaj Welfare Foundation. This is one of the largest Orphanages in Pakistan which will be used as a safe abode and pivotal point for a better education.

Why should we support the project?

- 1** The Orphan Care Home once complete will house and accommodate 500 children.
- 2** The children will go through formal education procedure; primary, secondary, college and university (The education will include both secular and religious education)
- 3** A lot of work has been done in completing this project and most importantly in ensuring the safety of the children.
- 4** Independent review has shown that this project will be the biggest of its kind being an asset to the developing world.



PROGRESS SINCE 2007

This project began with a pilot scheme that was to cater for just 50 Orphans that came from the Pakistan Earthquake disaster. Further plans are in place to extend this into a more comprehensive project with the aim of including the following:

- 1** A home like environment (of a middle class family) which will be different to any other project.
- 2** These are our children, this is our responsibility. We want to provide the donors an opportunity of treating these children as their own.
- 3** Excellent standard of education from primary all the way till University.
- 4** Excellent standard of living including; food, accommodation, study time, outdoor activities and efficient health care.
- 5** 24 hour around the clock care, YOU KNOW THEY ARE SAFE.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE

MWF has expanded the AGHOSH project throughout Pakistan. The same criteria for the orphans will apply. We will inevitably have hundreds of applicants and from the ones chosen, we will provide them a loving atmosphere, a high level of education and support till marriage and beyond.

MWF has spent millions on an efficient healthcare plan for the needy.

Since our founding, we have been providing free healthcare facilities, subsidising treatments, and promoting healthy lifestyles.

In locations where basic resources are inadequate, it is common to witness an ambulance arriving at a destination and to hear that the mother has lost her child or the individual who was involved in an accident has just passed away.

Thousand's of people lose their lives due to the inadequacy of ambulances or the number of them. Presently, MWF has established an Ambulance Service in **31 Regions** across Pakistan.

Work

MWF regularly organises **Annual Free Eye Surgery Camps** in which OPD Camps are Set up to provide **Free Eye Checks** to **thousands of people**. From here hundreds are referred, so they can receive further treatment and surgery. These camps are monitored by Senior Medical Experts.



EDUCATION

Minhaj Education Society (MES)

- 72 million are not enrolled in school. [2005 UN MDG Statistics]
- Civilizations are built on knowledge, and so education becomes an essential ingredient in the prosperity of nations. In many developing countries, it is the impoverished lower classes who are mostly deprived of education.
- Our sub-division Minhaj Education Society (MES) has established an unparalleled network of over 600 schools and colleges including a university to deliver free education to those can not afford it.
- MES also provides an endowment fund for widows and orphans thus eliminating any financial obstacles to study.
MES is likely the largest non-governmental education project in the whole world

EMERGENCY RELIEF

**NOTEABLE
WORK**

- 1.** Over Millions of pounds spent in rebuilding houses and infrastructure for the victims of the 2005 Pakistani Earthquake.
- 2.** After the Indonesian Tsunami MWF helped in the reconstruction of houses, providing fishing boats to victims so they could self sustain in terms of food and providing employment so that in excess of 120 families could fend for themselves post the disaster.
- 3.** Helped with the Providing aid in the following Emergency Disasters
 - East African Drought
 - Japan Tsunami
 - Haiti Earthquake
 - Bangladeshi Floods
 - Hunza Disaster
 - Kyrgyzstan Refugee Crisis
- 4.** MWF assembled 15,000 volunteers within 3 days of the Pakistan Floods in 2010.
- 5.** The MWF Team provided 400 trucks carrying rations, built 150 temporary relief camps and built 40 large tent settlements within a week of the Pakistani Flood Disaster.

MWF vision is women can play a vital role in the upbringing, stability and education of their children. This is why MWF has provided skilled training to women so they




